- □ The main contents of this agreement include: ▲ Gwangju City: Developing and operating a support program for nurturing the artificial intelligence industry, training for professionals, and employment-related programs ▲ CJ Olive Networks: Establishing a second research center in Gwangju to provide technical and policy advice for comprehensive IT services, such as artificial intelligence (AI) big data analysis, train human resources and create jobs ▲ GIST: Operate and provide artificial intelligence professional training programs, international joint research cooperation, and promotion of industry-university joint research with CJ Olive Networks.
- GIST Acting President In S. Kim said, "I hope this agreement will serve as an opportunity for the successful development of the artificial intelligence industry. We will do our best to revitalize the local economy by training specialists and creating jobs that will lead the era of the 4th Industrial Revolution."
