GIST conducts various social contribution activities to mark Children's Day in May

- GIST (Gwangju Institute of Science and Technology), to mark Children's Day in May, donated science books to five elementary schools on islands and in remote areas and also donated chicken to 20 institutions, including child welfare facilities.
- For 19 years this year, GIST has donated science books to elementary schools on islands and in remote areas and has consistently carried out social contribution activities for future aspiring students.
 - GIST delivered a total of 6 million won worth of books to five schools, including Yeosu Yeonam Elementary School, Gangjin Omcheon Elementary School, Haenam Hwasan Elementary School, Shinan Jeungdo Elementary School, and Namhae Gohyeon Elementary School.
- In addition, since 2017 with the sponsorship of Ajuker Chicken, GIST has been striving to establish social consensus and a donation culture. This year, about 230 chickens were shared once a month at children's and welfare facilities for the disabled.



- Ajuker Chicken sponsored 20 child care centers and infant care facilities, including Seongbin, Ilmaekwon, Shinaewon, Notre Dame Brothers' House, Aeyukwon, Donbosco Sharing House, Yongjin Childcare Center, Gwangju Nazare House, Welfare Facility for the Disabled, Sohwa Angel's House, Dandelion House, Bridge Happiness Villa, Pineville, House of Wheat, Sohwaseong Family, Eodeungjae Hwawon, and Aeil's House.
- Ajuker Chicken CEO Sun-sik Kim said, "We feel the reward and joy of being able to donate chicken through the GIST Social Contribution Program, and we hope that eating healthy snacks will help children find vitality and overcome the coronavirus."
 - Ajuker Chicken announced that it plans to continue sharing activities at nurseries and facilities for the disabled in the future with a policy of continuously spreading sharing to the marginalized neighbors in our area, rather than a one-time basis.
 - Ajuker Chicken announced that it plans to continue donation activities rather than a one-time basis at nurseries and facilities for the disabled in the future with a policy of continuously spreading donations to marginalized communities in our area.
- Yongjin Nursery School Director Eun-gang Jeong said, "We grateful to GIST and to Ajuker Chicken for their efforts to support social welfare, and we are happy to have a delicious snack with our children."
- GIST Vice President for Public Affairs Young-jip Kim said, "With the support of local brand Ajuker Chicken, it is even more meaningful to practice social contribution activities in conjunction with the local community. In the future, we plan to seek various social contribution activities for future students with aspirations of science."
