- GIST (Gwangju Institute of Science and Technology, President Kiseon Kim) held business consultations with Yeonggwang-gun (Governor Jun-seong Kim) held a business consultation for long-term balanced development and revitalization of local industries, including promotion of the smart e-mobility industry, industryuniversity cooperation, and nurturing specialists.

- For the promotion of the 2nd campus, GIST plans to carry out major projects such as the establishment of a smart e-mobility innovation center and activities to attract businesses in stages from 2021.
- Following this consultation, Yeonggwang-gun announced that it will provide all administrative and financial support to establish a smart e-mobility innovation center.
- GIST President Kiseon Kim said, "Through the Smart e-Mobility Innovation Center, it is expected that related industries such as artificial intelligence, energy, and mobility will develop, and industrial competitiveness will be strengthened through human resource training and demonstration. By applying artificial intelligence to e-mobility, the main industry of Yeonggwang-gun, and striving to attract companies and establish a GIST specialized graduate school, we will do our best to lay the foundation for future growth engines for the region and country."
- GIST is fulfilling its role and responsibility as a science and technology specialization university to foster human resources and conduct national artificial intelligence (AI) research suitable for the era of the 4th Industrial Revolution. It recently signed business agreements with CJ Olive Networks, Pyeongdong Industrial Complex Management Council, and Gwangju Metropolitan City Sustainable Development Council, and it is leading regional industrial innovation such as social problem-solving technology and promoting start-ups.
