GIST (Gwangju Institute of Science and Technology, President Kiseon Kim) Techno Management Business Academy (GTMBA) Alumni Association (President Seung-jong Na) held the 9th GTMBA regular general meeting and the inauguration ceremony of the general alumni president on January 31 (Tue) at GIST Oryong Hall.

The ceremony was attended by GIST President Kiseon Kim, Chairman Yong-beom Lee Protec Co., Ltd., and 120 alumni attended, and CEO Seung-jong Na of Hyojin Co., Ltd. was elected as the 6th Chairman of the Association.

Hyojin Co., Ltd., founded in 1996 by Seung-jong Na, a 7th GTMBA alumni, is a company specializing in electrical engineering and construction. Major industries include electrical construction, firefighting construction, and installation and maintenance of firefighting construction.

Meanwhile, the GIST Techno Management Business Academy invited Gwangju Metropolitan City Mayor Ki-jeong Kang as a speaker to the <GIST Academy Forum> held as a pre-event and gave a special lecture on the '2023 Gwangju Municipal Administration Plan'.

Mayor Ki-jeong Kang gave a lecture focusing on pending projects of Gwangju City: ▲ Jisan IC, installation of an underground roadway at Baegun Square ▲ Development of new textile sites in Jeonnam and Japan ▲ Development of Eodeungsan Tourism Complex ▲ Attraction of a shopping mall ▲ Relocation of a military airport.

The GIST Academy operates the Techno Management Business Academy (GTMBA, opened in 2010) and the Climate Change Academy (GCCA, opened in 2016) as non-degree courses, and is recruiting new students for the 13th class of GTMBA and the 6th class of GCCA in 2023. The training targets include CEOs and executives, high-ranking public officials, and opinion leaders from all walks of life, and about 40 people were recruited.
