The Gwangju Institute of Science and Technology (GIST, President Kichul Lim) announced that it will hold artist Yong-rim Jang's <The Flower Comes Again> as the first invitational exhibition in 2024 at Oryong Art Hall, which is an exhibition space on campus.

In this invitational exhibition, a total of 33 Korean paintings in which the artist reinterpreted traditional color paintings using modern techniques to bring out the beautiful colors of nature are on display.

Artist Yong-rim Jang, who graduated from Chonnam National University's Department of Art Education and the same graduate school, works at Lotte Gallery and Gwangju Museum of Art. He has held numerous solo and group exhibitions at Kumho Gallery and others, and he won the Uijae Heo Baek-ryeon Special Award at the Gwangju Culture and Arts Awards.

Artist Jang mainly presents works that contain literary lyricism with Korean materials and has expressed the sublimity of life, the breath of nature, and the harmony between nature and fate that are felt in the process of flowers blooming and falling in his works.

The moonlit white plum blossoms that fill the Oryong Art Hall, the cotton blossoms that seem to breathe in a moon jar, and the blue plum blossoms that show off their clean and clear aura, draw colorful images and make the viewer look forward to the spring that is slowly approaching from afar.

In particular, the red plum blossoms that fill the canvas with the light red spring breeze emphasize the theme of this exhibition that the long winter will soon pass and, as always, spring will come again.

Artist Yong-rim Jang said, "The plum blossoms that have survived the winter always give off an indescribable scent, and even in the snow, the plum blossoms bloom and convey their fragrance. At this invitational exhibition, I hope that people will experience the feast of spring through the plum blossoms that have survived the winter and bloomed."
