The Gwangju Institute of Science and Technology (GIST, President Kichul Lim) announced that it successfully held the '1st GIST Science Imagination Children's Art Contest' on Saturday, May 18 and announced the winning works on Monday, May 27.

The winning work will be displayed until June 30 on the 3rd floor of 'Oryong Art Hall', an exhibition space created by GIST on the inner wall of Oryong Hall, a multi-purpose building on campus to provide a venue for community exchange and cooperation.

Meanwhile, this art contest, which accepted participation in kindergarten / lower grades (grades 1 to 3) / upper grades (grades 4 to 6), included  $\blacktriangle$  science (artificial intelligence, space, biotechnology, etc.) under the slogan 'Draw the future' and imaginative drawings related to or  $\checkmark$  GIST landscapes with imagination were given as topics.

This past April, GIST, which established a new vision for external cooperation to 'advance to the future with the region' by adding 'sharing' to science and technology, was the first art contest held for children, and was held with great interest from the local community.

About 400 people, including the participants' families, visited the GIST campus, and the children took a seat under the shade canopies installed throughout the campus and freely let their imaginations run wild on drawing paper.

Soon-Im Choi, Art Director of Oryong Art Hall, said, "All of the submitted works not only well captured the theme of the competition, but also showed off their original imagination, so the skills of the participating children exceeded expectations. This art contest was a valuable experience for me as an evaluator as it seemed to be an event where our children, who are dreamers of future science, could freely unleash their scientific imagination."
