**A. Details:**

• **Participants**

Ph.D. Students / ONLY one time while in school

• **Visiting period**

Maximum 15 days

• **Approval of Academic Advisor**

Applicants have to submit their plans containing approval of their advisor.

• **Information(PR) activities**

Participants have to distribute leaflets and brochures and post our information posters.

(TASA and CISS will provide the leaflets, brochures and posts.)

Participants have to explain GIST to international students

and to consult about studying in GIST with them.

**B. Requirements:**

• Applicants should be current Ph.D. students of GIST and have Bachelor or Master degrees from their countries.

• Applicants have to complete the form(Plan for Visiting Alma Mater) and send it to TASA individually.

\*Ensure efficient processing, please provide your exact phone number and email address.

**C. Procedure:**

• TASA will review all applicants' plans and select successful participants.

• TASA will regard countries and schools(universities) and select participants not to be crowded to some countries or some schools.

• Even though applicants don't get a chance to visit their countries this time, they can apply

again next time.

- The final result will be announced through GIST Bulletin Board and TASA will contact successful participants individually.

**D. Supports:**

- Round-trip Airfare(economic class): maximum 1,500,000 Korean won
- Activity Expenses: maximum 500,000 Korean won
- \* All participants must submit documentary evidence for activity expenses.

- May. 15 : Submission Deadline
- May. 29 : Final Decision & Notification of successful participants
- Jun. 15 : Starting Visiting Alma Mater
- Nov. 30 : Ending Visiting Alma Mater and submission of Visiting Report
