- GIST (Gwangju Institute of Science and Technology) announced on the 8th that it participated in the "Go! Go! Challenge," a campaign to remove plastic in daily life hosted by the Ministry of Environment.
  - The Go Go Challenge is a public interest campaign that the Ministry of Environment started in January to reduce plastic in daily life.
  - GIST Vice President for Public Affairs Young-jip Kim, who was nominated for the challenge by Seong-hwa Na, president of the Gwangju Economic and Employment Promotion Agency, said, "GIST doesn't use plastic bags to help reduce plastic waste. We are trying to preserve the environment, such as using a shopping cart instead."
