Senior Researcher Kang is also working to enhance local residents' understanding of the energy sector and strengthen their capabilities by planning programs to develop the energy industry in Gwangju City at large-scale events such as the 'Korea Climate, Environment, and Energy Expo (KEET 2024. 8. 28. ~ 30.)' and the 'Bitgaram International Electric Power Technology Expo (BIXPO 2024. 11. 6. ~ 11. 8.)' to be held at the Kim Dae-jung Convention Center in August.

In addition, as a member of the Energy Division of the Investment Attraction Advisory Group of the Gwangju Free Economic Zone Authority, he actively participates in various consultations and discussions for attracting companies and is also cooperating in preparing the '2024 International Investment Attraction Forum' program scheduled to be held by the Gwangju Free Economic Zone Authority on November 29.
