3. Eligibility for application

- To increase project's concentration, in principle, one student may participate in one project.
- Participants in the past Infinite Challenge projects (2016-2021) can also apply and participate.
- After completion of the project, the performance report and performance results must be
 submitted (if not submitted, completion is not recognized)
- ** The project implementation team must comply with the quarantine rules to prevent the spread of COVID-19 (if not complied, they may be subject to sanctions).

4. Period of implementation and the amount of project grants

- □ Performance Period: May 2, 2022 ~ October 31, 2022 (6 months)
- □ Course Credit: One credit may be given as a creative cultivation course(UC0202) (S/U, recognized after checking the activity history)
- * It is recommended to complete course registration and credit recognition in the relevant year of activity.
