❖ Mobility Program(Overseas Student Exchange Program)

- Expanding capacity as an international campus and fostering outstanding global talents through student exchanges with cooperative universities that have concluded overseas student exchange agreements
- (Outbound) Accreditation of credits obtained by sending 2nd to 4th graders (~7th semester) to universities that sign agreements in various countries for one semester to complete a regular curriculum

Applicants are responsible for checking the language requirements of the university they wish to apply to before applying

Students should consider before dispatch.
Criteria for Scholarship return	- Fees incurred when canceled due to personal reasons after final selection (when incurred) - Program not completed due to personal reasons → Full scholarship refund ※ Those who return home in the middle of the semester due to health problems and those who are excluded from the selection (disciplinary action, etc.) are considered "cancellation of personal reasons"

- ③ English Proficiency Test Score(TOEFL/TOEIC/CEFR/IELTS)
- ④ Supporting documents for various awards, volunteer activities, and other activities listed in the application (limited to relevant individuals).

B. Remarks for the application ★Important★ Please read it before submitting

- All submitted documents must be in A4 size PDF format
- **Inaccurate or incomplete information on documents** will result in automatic exclusion from the selection process without further notice
- All submissions must be scanned files (photographs of documents will not be accepted)
- All documents must have the same English name as your passport.
- Academic transcripts: Only official transcripts issued by the institution's transcript office or through the university's online student service system will be accepted (**Printouts or captured images from ZEUS are not accepted**)
- All submitted documents must be submitted after unlocking the password (security)
- All files must be valid on the submission date(documents with issuance dates in the future are not valid)
- **The application must be written by the applicant. The use of AI (artificial intelligence) in preparing the application is prohibited**
