- Essays should be original essays and cannot have been published previously or edited from essays previously submitted in other classes.
- All essays should be the students' own original work.
- Any entrants who plagiarize will be disqualified from this, and future contests.
- By submitting an essay to the contest, students accept full responsibility for adhering to the rules laid out above and accept responsibility for submitting their submissions through the correct channels and within the deadline. The English Education Center accepts no responsibility for any late submissions or misunderstandings on the part of students.
